Expectations & Learning Outcomes (Years 7–9)

1. Purpose of Study

KS3 English aims to ensure pupils:

- **Read fluently** and with understanding
- **Write clearly and accurately** for a range of purposes
- **Speak confidently** in formal and informal contexts
- Develop **cultural, emotional, intellectual and social maturity**
- Appreciate **our rich literary heritage**

2. Aims of KS3 English (Core Learning Outcomes)

By the end of KS3, pupils should be able to:

- **Read widely** (fiction, non-fiction, poetry, drama, Shakespeare)
- **Analyse language, structure and form**
- **Write for different audiences and purposes**
- **Use accurate spelling, punctuation and grammar**
- **Speak and listen effectively** in discussions, debates and presentations
- **Develop vocabulary** and understand linguistic conventions

3. Reading – Expectations & Outcomes

Pupils must read a **broad, challenging range** of texts:

Skills Developed

- Inference & deduction
- Analysis of writer's methods
- Understanding of context
- Comparison of texts
- Critical evaluation
- Appreciation of literary heritage

4. Writing – Expectations & Outcomes

Pupils should learn to:

- Write **accurately and coherently**
- Adapt tone, style and register
- Plan, draft, edit and proofread
- Write **creative texts** (narrative, descriptive)
- Write **analytical essays**
- Use **SPAG** accurately
- Use ambitious vocabulary

5. Spoken Language – Expectations & Outcomes

Pupils should:

- Use **Standard English** confidently
- Participate in **formal debates**
- Deliver **presentations**
- Use talk to explore ideas
- Listen actively and respond appropriately
- Work collaboratively

6. Grammar, Vocabulary & Language Study

Pupils should:

- Consolidate KS2 grammar knowledge
- Use **linguistic terminology** accurately
- Understand how language choices affect meaning
- Use varied and ambitious vocabulary
- Apply grammar and punctuation consistently

7. Overall Attainment Target (End of KS3)

By the end of KS3, pupils should:

- **Speak, read and write fluently and confidently**
- Show secure understanding of texts
- Communicate effectively in speech and writing
- Demonstrate progress across reading, writing and spoken language
- Be prepared for **GCSE English Language & Literature**
